

- **General BusinessFile**  
This is an index of 5,100 periodicals, with full-text articles from 4,200, though not all are current. Sources inclu sources. The Economist Intelligence Unit country profiles are here, too. You can search for keyword, subject t
- **General OneFile**  
This is a compilation of other Gale databases, indexing 12,000 periodicals and offering at least some full text fr but you will find articles on some academic subjects as well. Gale's Academic OneFile is the scholarly counter
- **General Reference Center**  
A good general index, this covers 5,300 periodicals and has full text for 4,000 of them. You'll find current affai several small encyclopedias, handbooks, and dictionaries.
- **Google Scholar**  
The academic side of Google is here, retrieving articles, chapters, books, and reports from university presses your "Scholar Preferences" at the top and see "Resources @ My Library" among your search results.
- **GPO Access**
